

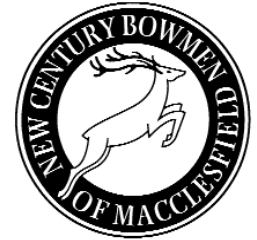

JACK & JILL TROPHIES for Recurve & Compound, (*For husbands and wives only*).

A team of 3 archers from one club all shooting senior rounds, one of which must be a lady or a junior shooting the round of their gender.

Awards for both Double and Single Round entries
in all styles and age groups according to entry.

RECORD STATUS SHOOTs will be liable for Drug Testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If competitors refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

PHOTOGRAPHY. In order to comply with the GNAS Protection of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.

G.N.A.S. Rules of Shooting (including dress rules) will apply.

If the tournament is abandoned, trophies / medals shall be awarded up to and including the last complete end shot.
